

FIELD RULES

- Flying hours for fueled planes:
 - Monday through Saturday from 10:00 AM. until 7:00 PM.
 - Sunday, 12:00 PM. until 7:00 PM.
 - Electric powered aircraft are exempt from these time restrictions.
- Do not fly over or near homes & buildings behind the woods across from the field.
- Flying over pit area is forbidden. Do not taxi in the pit area.
- All engines must have effective mufflers. Noise levels are to be kept low. Maximum noise level: 97DB at nine feet.
- Transmitter control procedures must be followed at all times.
- Take-offs and landings should be into the prevailing wind, and that pattern flown when more than one aircraft is flown.
- It is the duty of all fliers to obey and enforce all safety flight procedures and courtesy rules at all times.
- Current membership in the A.M.A. is required.
- ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND DRUGS are strictly forbidden.
- Flying at the field is reserved for members only. Each member is permitted one guest who must have a current membership in the A.M.A.
- DO NOT LITTER THE FIELD. Place trash in area trash cans, and butts in butt cans.
- All aircraft must be airworthy.
- All new members will be flight checked by an experienced pilot member.
- USE FREQUENCY PINS AT ALL TIMES.
- Maintain a fire extinguisher in the Pin Box available for use when flying.
